## COMMISSIONERS COURT SCHEDULES WELCOME FOR NEW DISTRICT CLERK THERESA CHANG

Newest County Department Head To Be Sworn In This Afternoon

Harris County Commissioners Court has scheduled a welcoming ceremony and reception this afternoon for Theresa Chang, the county's new district clerk.

Chang, who was unanimously selected Tuesday by the county's 59 district court judges, is currently the chief of the compliance division for the Harris County Attorney's Office.

"The commissioners and I look forward to working with Theresa, and we know she'll do a great job in the District Clerk's office, returning the office to the task of overseeing court records and jury summonses," said Harris County Judge Ed Emmett. "We want to make sure from the start that Theresa knows she has our full support."

Chang is expected to be sworn in by District Judge Mark Davidson at 2 p.m. today in the Commissioners Courtroom on the ninth floor of the County Administration Building at 1001 Preston in downtown Houston. The reception by Commissioners Court will follow immediately after.

Chang will be available to meet with the media immediately following the ceremony.
